RNDR designs and codes the future, by transforming data into information, information into knowledge, and knowledge into narratives. To achieve this, we develop processes, create structures, design visualisations, code programs, and create interactions. The end result can manifest itself across different media, ranging from interactive installations, to print and everything in between —often real-time. We are triggered by how information and technology transforms networks, cultures, societies, relationships, behaviours, and interactions between people. The work of RNDR is only finished by its use. RNDR was founded in 2017 in The Hague, (NL). Its main members have years of experience as partners, computer scientists, designers, and developers at LUST and LUSTlab. Jeroen Barendse (1973, Poeldijk) initially wanted to become an artist, but eventually entered Graphic Design at the Academy of the Arts, Utrecht. After two years, he continued his studies at the Academy of Arts in Arnhem. Here he discovered the diversity of all the aspects of the design curriculum. He set up design studio LUST in 1996 and from 1998-1999 he was involved in the Werkplaats Typografie (Arnhem), a post-graduate design program. From 2001, Jeroen has taught Graphic Design and Interactive Design at the Academy of Arts, Arnhem. In 2010 he set up LUSTlab, an experimental research studio connected to LUST. He was a jury member of Indesem. He taught numerous workshops, won many design prizes and given lectures all around the world. Jeroen is one of the founding members of LUST. After the discontinuation of LUST and LUSTlab in 2017 he set up RNDR with Edwin Jakobs and Boyd Rotgans. In 2017 he was awarded the Piet Zwart oeuvre prize.

Visiting the nine departments and their multitude of spaces is like embarking on an initiatory journey towards a new theory of design. Unfortunately, not everyone can visit this infinite museum dedicated to the splendor and variety of graphic languages. For this reason, the curator has designed itinerant pop-up boxes that provide insights into this great collective project. Each chest houses a selection of objects connected to a particular space in The Palace of

Typographic Masonry. The complete collection is revealed by the cards placed above the chests. Many commissioned works reflect on the departments of the palace investigating their veiled mystery. This “alphabet of caskets” will be exhibited for the first time ever during “Graphic Days® - Eyes On the Netherlands” in Turin. 




